Coding with The Shroud of Turin

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Students coded to collect blood data found on the Shroud of Turin. Students watched a Shroud of Turin 3D modelling investigation video and Father Bob provided a religious instruction session about the shroud. The coding with the Shroud of Turin project was recognized by EWTN Facebook and through www.ohio.com.

INPUTS	Computer science class, Father Bob Stec's class lecture
OUTCOMES	Students were able to successfully code to collect data that determines how much blood was on the Shroud of Turin.
LEARNING IMPACTS	Students were able to more respectfully understand the sacrifice of Jesus after collecting his blood through imagery analysis and coding. After completing this impact class, students' faith increased due to their STEM involvement on the shroud.
