**Suggested Optional ~ Student Selected** – students are encouraged to read at least two books from the list below.

#### **1. Wordless Books**

*Wordless books are an excellent means to stimulate a young child's language development. When reading this book, look at the pictures together with your child and take turns telling the story. Some examples are:*

- *Carl books, such as Carl's Birthday , Good Dog, Carl , by Alexandra Day*
- *Pancakes for Breakfast by Tomie de Paola*

#### **2. Nursery Rhymes or Mother Goose**

Good selections for this category include collections by Marguerite De Angeli and Tom Glazer

#### **3. ABC Books**

*If You Give a Mouse A Cookie and other titles by Laura Numeroff*

#### **4. Counting Books**

*How Big Were the Dinosaurs? by Bernard Most*

*Sea Shapes by Suse MacDonald*

*How Many? How Many? How Many? By Rick Walton*

*Dinner at the Panda Palace by Stephanie Calmerson*

#### **5. Color Word Books**

*Brown Bear, Brown Bear, What Do You See? By Bill Martin is a must read in this category.*
