HOW TO ADMINISTER EPINEPHRINE

EpiPen and Epipen Jr. Directions:

1. Pull of blue safety release
2. Swing and firmly push orange tip against outer thigh so it “clicks”.
3. Hold on thigh for 10 seconds to administer medication.
4. Do not discard injector – to be given to paramedics.

AuviQ directions: (Injector has vocal instruction when in use)

1. Pull off red safety guard.
2. Place black end against thigh then press firmly and hold in place for 5 seconds.
3. Do no discard injector – to be given to paramedics.
