The 28th Annual Bishops' Scholarship for Excellence

Up to \$3,500 for High School Scholarships Grades 9–12 and
Up to \$1,200 for Elementary School Scholarships Grades 6–8

Application for the
2026-2027 School Year

The Catholic Education Endowment Trust (CEET) was established in 1976 by the Catholic Diocese of Cleveland to promote Catholic education, provide support for religious programs, and to offer tuition aid and scholarships to families with financial need who desired a Catholic education for their children. As part of this initiative, CEET started the *Bishops' Scholarship* to encourage *Excellence* in Catholic education.

Guidelines and Requirements of the Scholarship

- The completed *Bishops' Scholarship for Excellence* application must include:
 1. An essay written by the student, typed and double-spaced using traditional font, such as Times New Roman, Ariel, Cambria, or Calibri in 12pt, with 1-inch margins and a minimum of two pages/maximum of three pages, on the following topic:

Pier Giorgio Frassati, a young Italian, died of polio at the age of 24 and was recently canonized, but in his short life he was known for his social and political activism and his service to the poor. He was never afraid to defend his faith. Pier Giorgio also loved sports, especially mountain climbing, and he used climbing expeditions as a chance to lead his friends to Mass, scripture, and praying the rosary. Though it was not his motto in life, “Verso l’alto” was frequently associated with Saint Pier Giorgio Frassati after his death because he wrote it on a picture of him mountain climbing, which ended up being his last climb before his death. The phrase means “to the heights” or “toward the top.”

Give a specific example with clear details of how some aspect of your life reflects one of the traits of Pier Giorgio Frassati: social or political activism, serving the poor, or bringing others to the faith through sports or another activity. Then explain how you could take your actions “to the heights” to better serve God. In what ways could you do more to serve others?

2. A completed **FACTS Grant and Aid** application for 2026-2027 to determine need; <https://online.factsmgmt.com/aid>.
 3. The student’s academic transcript or current report card.
 4. A brief recommendation e.g., from a teacher, guidance counselor, or a parish staff member (not a family member) on page 4.
 5. Principal recommendation and signature on page 5.
- A separate application for each student is required if a family has more than one child applying for the Scholarship
 - Applications are only open to students attending a Diocesan Tuition Assistance (DTA) participating school in the Catholic Diocese of Cleveland for the 2026-2027 academic year. Check with the school to verify.
 - Students must return completed applications to their school office.
 - School must submit all applications to the Office of Catholic Education by **March 15th**
 - Scholarship Recipients will be notified by mail in early May/2026.
